



Dear Lodi Curling Club Members,

On behalf of the Lodi Curling Club (LCC) Board of Directors I am thrilled to inform you today that we will return to the ice this year at the club! At the most recent board meeting, we made the decision to have a 2021-2022 curling season. I hope this news makes you smile as much as it does all of us.

While everyone is excited about having a curling season and getting the leagues back into action, the group had to have two primary discussions. First, create and maintain a safe experience for our membership. Second, to find the most feasible way to collect dues and registration information. As many of you know Jim Ness was an incredible board member and really helped with many club operations which we don't have the resources to sustain. Here are some of the specific decisions that have been made for the upcoming season:

Health and Safety

- **To curl this year, you must be vaccinated.**
- At the time of registration, each team member's vaccination card must be shown.
- Children under 12 will need to wear a mask while in the club, or until an approved vaccination is available to them, and they are vaccinated.
- Any spectators and guests, over the age of 12, must be vaccinated.

Season Details

- Our amazing icemen will begin the process of creating ice October 25, 2021.
- Leagues will begin November 15, 2021 and run through the second week of March.
- We will determine our annual Bonspiel schedule at our next meeting.

Dues

- Regular Member dues (unlimited weekly league play) will be \$250.
- First time curler dues (unlimited weekly league play) will be \$200 and will include a broom and glider.
- Dues will be due the first week of curling, which is November 15, 2021.
- Dues not paid in the first week, will be assessed a \$50 late fee and due by December 1, 2021.
- Individual dues not collected before December 31, 2021 will result in forfeiture of a team's games after January 1, 2022.
- The club will be creating a venmo account to simplify the payment and collection process for members.

Later this month, we will be working out more of the details/specifics of the season. I want to extend my sincerest thanks to the entire LCC Board for making this decision and working out the millions of details that go into running the club and leagues, as well as having a full season.
